

Commissioner's Office July 28th 1839. The parties interested in the Settlement of Richard Halcome's Estate administered by Mary Halcome were again notified to attend before me on Monday the 29th of September to give evidence in relation to the Board of Elders Halcome who is one of the distributees, and from the evidence to be taken together with all the circumstances the Court is clearly of opinion that he is ought to be charged for the year ending from 1825 to 1826 both years as inclusives. This Account was again continued at the instance of Richard Scott, who is interested in right of his late wife a Miss Mary Halcome, who was one of the distributees, so he did put in an Account for Board for himself and children charged by the administration, and sundry witnesses were examined and affidavits taken, from which the Court is clearly of opinion that not less than two years Board ought to be charged which would embrace the years in fact 1826, 1827, & 1828. The parties admit that the administration is entitled to Board for Susanna Halcome for the year 1818. who was and was at the said Richard's death, he had the sum of \$8. Richard and Mary Halcome admit for years Board ending in the year 1821 as charged by administration.
