In the name of God Amen I, Sepe Fort of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia being of sound mind but unable to write do Make and Ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form as follows to wit.

Item 1st I Give all my just debts paid out of the property that now is my possession

Item 2nd I Give to my beloved wife Elizabeth the balance of my property consisting of land Negroes namely, Selah, Cynthia, John, Anthony, Arthur, Tim, Marck and Charles household and kitchen furniture plantations animals Crops of every kind Stock of horses Cattle Sheep hogs, as well as all other property of what kind I have during her natural life. It is my Will that my daughter Elizabeth be paid out of my Estate so long as she lives single

Item 3rd At the death of my wife I Give my daughter, Nancy my land whereon I now live, Jordan, Anthony and Mary.

Item 4th The Balance of my property I Give to be equally divided between my daughters Sally, Thospe and Nancy Fort.

I hereby constitute and appoint John T. Harrod my whole and sole Executor
