

I give to my wife Mary Donald Blunt my negro woman Mary and her increase from this day, also my bedsteads, beds and bed-furniture not disposed of, all my table linen, napkins and towels, all my Crockery, China and Glass ware of every description, all my paster, my Tea Spoons and Sugar Tongs all my knives and forks, a large Copper Kettle and Silver Coffee urn, all my Cedar Casks and Barrels and perfect two barrelled carts, wheels, all my Carts, One Ox Chain, all my Ox yokes, all the meat packing for family use, also a sufficient quantity of Corn and for deer for her use during the year it may happen that I should die, all the luggage laid out for family uses; also Ten breeding Sows and their litters of any together with Sheats enough to make provision for her family a year if so many there be, four Black Sheep the best, ten other Cattle the best, all my Stock of Sheep, my looms and the apparatus belonging to them all my Spinning wheels I care for nothing and wool, all the better land in for family uses, all my ploughs and gear Six oxen and six Working hoes, Six grubbing hoes, all my plough hoes, six Mules if so many there be first choice if not any number under that may be. I also give her my Carriage and Harness and the horses I bought of E Muller, also my Kitchen utensils of every kind. I give her also all my household stuffs not before disposed of, I lend her during her life my three Copper Kettles, Caps and Worms, also a large iron Kettle for Stewing Hogs. I lend to my wife during the minority of my Sons William Henry Blunt and Walter Fraser Blunt all my Slaves not given away except yellow John and Andrew Son. I give yellow John to my Son Walter Fraser Blunt and Andrew to my son William Henry Blunt to them and their heirs. I lend my wife during her life all my land lying on the West side of Buckhorn Swamp, the loan of the lands and Slaves is intended for the maintenance of herself, William Henry Blunt, Walter Fraser Blunt, Simon Fraser Blunt, and Angus and Frances Marion Blunt. If any of the Slaves loaned to my wife Mary Donald Blunt should become unmanageable or refractory, I desire that they may be sold by my Executor hereafter, to be mortgaged and the amount of Sales to be divided equally between William Henry Blunt, Walter Fraser Blunt, Simon Fraser Blunt, and Angus and Frances Marion Blunt. If Simon Fraser and Frances Marion Blunt to be held by them and their heirs forever. At the death of my wife I desire the Copper Kettle Caps and worm and the large iron Kettle for Stewing hogs may be sold and the proceeds fairly divided between William Henry and Walter Fraser Blunt. All my land lying on the West Side of Buckhorn Swamp at the death of my wife I desire may be sold either privately or at public sale, as my Executor may think fit and the amount equally divided between William Henry Blunt, Walter Fraser Blunt, Angus and Simon Fraser Blunt.

Whereas I have given off to my Son James Reddy Blunt and to my daughter Mary Elizabeth Peete and Martha Peete Bonner their full proportion of my Estate they are not to be concerned as further relates to any part of it. I Appoint Samuel Blunt Executor to this my last Will and Testament.
