With Interest therein from January 1832, till paid also of \$50. due the 1<sup>st</sup> January 1834 and the further Sum of \$79. 48. due the 1<sup>st</sup> January 1835.

The Intestate sold to the adm<sup>r</sup> Sason Rowe in the fall 1832 a negro woman on the following terms of \$50. payable January 1/1832, of \$50. payable January 1/1833, of \$50. payable January 1<sup>st</sup> 1834, and of \$79. 48. payable January 1/1835. and it is contended by Patrick Rowe and Sally Rowe Legates that the Sale is fraudulent, inasmuch as the said intestate, was and always had been on Compulsion to make Contracts, from a natural defect of her mind, and they introduced Juny W. Trepel to establish this fact. Some of the W. Trepel's prove that the intestate had bargained with a negro trader for this negro (a short time before Sason Rowe bought her) for \$500 Cash; and that the said Sason objected in consequence of this or capacity to transact business &c. All the evidence is filed and Submitted to the Court.
