Thompson to establish this fact. Some of the Wm. Thompson know that the Intestate had bargained with a negro trader for this negro (a short time before Jason Rowe bought him) at \$ 800 cash; and that the said Jason objected in consequence of his incapacity to transact business w ^c .
