Wills

In the Name of God Amen. I Daniel Rutt of Prichampson County and Parish of St. John's being of full age and sound mind do make and Ordain this as my last Will and Testament revoking all former Wills by me heretofore made in manner and form following
1st It is my Will and desire that my wife Polly Rutt should have and enjoy the use of my Manor plantations &c herein I now live containing by less four hundred acres during her natural life it is also my Will that my wife take to her part one third of the negroes to her use during her natural life and no longer the land and negroes as above mentioned
2nd It is also my Will and desire, after my just debts being paid and my wife after having received such part as may then be allotted to her that the other two thirds of my negroes be equally divided personally between my four Sons (that is) Edward A. Rutt, Henry M. Rutt, Francis P. Rutt and George M. Rutt, and at the decease of my wife her part of the negroes to be divided as above to my four Sons as already named to them and their heirs for ever

3rd It is also my Will and desire that all my lands not heretofore disposed of that is in dispute for, or that may come to the Estate be advertised and sold on a Credit of Three months the purchaser giving Bond and good personal Security with a Vow of Truth if required on the land to secure the payment of the purchase money. It is my Will and desire that the land be sold to my wife at her decease be advertised and sold as above directed and the proceeds equally divided between my four Sons as above named provided Edward A. Rutt pay to the Estate four hundred and ninety five dollars at once when more than the other Children without paying interest on the same, then he shall be entitled to share his full proportion as above directed to them and their heirs for ever.

Now It is my Will that my wife have her part of all my stock and that she have the disposal of my household furniture Bed &c and Plate.

And Lastly I do hereby Constitute and appoint my wife and my Sons Edward A. Rutt and Henry M. Rutt my whole and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament revoking all other Wills by me heretofore made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 18th day of October in the year of our Lord 1831.
