At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 16th day of September 1832.

This last Will and Testament of Thomas B. Bloss decd. was proved to the satisfaction of Phineas H. Bailey and J. A. Hallaway two of the Witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of Phineas H. Bailey (Peyton T. Bailey the Executor therein named appeared in Court and refused to take upon himself the burden of the Executors duty) who made oath and together with Patrick Bates and John S. Smalley his Securus entered into and acknowledged a Bond with penalty of Five hundred dollars conditioned as the Law directs. Certificate is granted him for obtaining Letters of administration on the said Thomas B. Bloss's Estate with his Will aforesaid annexed as due form.

And lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my friend Patrick Bates the whole and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby declaring all other Wills or Wills heretofore made by
