

I, a My Wife and desire it for my home plantation so here I now live on and all my other property be immediately sold after my death and after paying all my just debts the surplus of any to be divided in the following manner Viz. My son and Son-in-law One fifth part of what my plantations doth sell for to him and that his share of the balance of the Land money and all my other personal estate that is not drawn for thus to be sold and the money equally divided between my grand children of Elizabeth Whitehead, Ann Davis, Mildred Williams and Temperance Drake to be equally divided among the children of my granddaughters and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint Solomon Williams of my Executor of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 23rd day of August in the year of our Lord 1830.

Signed Sealed published and declared by the said Testator Jordan Jones as and for his last Will and Testament in the presence of us who have subscribed our names as Witnesses in the presence of of the said Testator.

Judgment is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form.
