My son Archibald Brown the one fifth part of what my plantations doth sell for to him and that he receive the balance of the Land money and all my other personal estate that is not drawn for thus will to be sold and the money equally divided between my grand children of Elizabeth Whitehead, Ann Davis, Mildred Williams and Temperance Drake to be equally divided among the children of my grand daughter Archibald's Son being Constable and appoint Thomas Walliser of my Executor of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 23rd day of August in the year of our Lord 1830.
