There was a negro woman & a child about one year old which the Guardian could not hear for any thing in 1806 and she kept them from that time and by mutual consent of the parties interested, it was left to Henry Bailey and Benjamin Cobb who decided the Guardian ought not to be charged for any time till 1813 and I am informed Emma Simmons was twenty three years old on September 1812.
