

with his future increased which said negro girl Mitty he now has in possession, with one half of my Cider barrels & Tons and 1/2th also after the decease of intermarriage of all my daughter. I then give to my Son Sugars Lami the upwards land and it shall be loaned to my daughter upwards. Item 3rd I give to my daughter Polly Mollens one negro girl named Mandy now in her possession also one bed and furniture commonly called a Trundle bed. Item 4th I give to my grand daughter Elizabeth Ann Mollens one negro boy child named Peter to her and her heirs forever.

Item 5th All the remainder of my negroes and household goods and all the balance of the balance of my property of what nature or kind I now own given as aforesaid I desire to be equally divided between my daughters named Lucy, Emma, Polly, Polly, and Catherine to them and their heirs forever.

6th And lastly I do hereby constitute and desire my son Sugars Lami shall be my Executor to this my last will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 9th day of December 1830.

This last Will and Testament of Joseph Lami deceased was proved by the oath of Jesse Drury and William D. Hood one of the Witnesses thereto and is ordered to be accorded. And on the motion of Sugars Lami the Executor therein named doth make oath and together with John Hicks and John Lami his securities entered into and acknowledge a Bond in the penalty of \$1000 and dollars conditioned as the Law directs. Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of said Will in due form.
