and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say
First I give and bequeath unto my Sister Polly Story all my land and plantation known as
Neside containing by estimation three hundred and fourteen acres more or less to her and her heirs
2nd After my decease I desire that my funeral expenses and all my just debts paid out for
personal estate by my Executor herein after named.

3rd After the payment of my funeral expenses and my just debts I give and bequeath
the balance of my Estate of every description to my said Sister Polly Story to her and her heirs
Partly I hereby nominate and appoint my friends John M. Gentry and Thomas D. Wood
Executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other former
or Testaments by me hitherto made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
my seal this 14th day of September. In the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred
thirty three.
