In the Name of God. Amen. I Joseph Haniff of the County of Dorchester in the State of Virginia do hereby make and Ordain this paper writing as and for my last Will and Testament in manner and form following (that is to say).

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Turner fifty dollars in Cash to my said daughter raised out of my Estate to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son ~~Joseph~~ Haniff five dollars in Cash, herein what I have heretofore given him which he has in possession to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Johnson wife of John Johnson the sum of fifty dollars in Cash to be raised out of my Estate after my death herein what I have heretofore given her to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Henry Haniff one Section of land of James B. Rockwell his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Matchum Haniff five dollars in Cash herein what I have heretofore given him to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son William Haniff five dollars in Cash herein what I have heretofore given him to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Polly Haniff two Section of land and furniture, a cow and calf, one desk and one hundred dollars in Cash to be raised out of my Estate to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son John Haniff the sixty acres of land I purchased of Nelson Wader, one bay horse, two black and white and furniture, together with all the remaining part of my Estate of every nature and kind what so ever after paying my just debts and the legacies herein before named to him and his heirs forever.

Lastly I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my John Haniff as my sole and true Executor to this my last Will and Testament, according to the will by me made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twelfth day of November 1833.
