In the Name of God Amen I Henry Harris of the County of Southampton being of Sound mind and memory do hereby certify that I have made this paper writing as and for my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows Viz.

Item My Will and desire is that my Executor hereinafter named do sell all my Estate of every kind whatsoever both real and personal and divide the proceeds thereof after paying my just debts to the following persons and in the following manner I give and bequeath to my Sister Polly Harris the Sum of fifty dollars to her and her heirs forever I give and bequeath to my Sister Sarah Harris One month part of the Remainder of my Estate to her and her heirs forever I give and bequeath to my Brother Samuel Harris One month part as above to him and his heirs forever I also give and bequeath to each of the following persons namely Henry Turner the wife of Jacobus Turner, Matthew Harris William Harris John Harris Polly Harris and Jacobus Doyal One month part of my Estate after the payment of fifty dollars as above to them and their heirs forever I send the use of One month part of my Estate (after the legacy as above) to my Sister Rebecca Johnson the wife of William Johnson for and during her natural life and at her death to return to my distributees to be equally divided between them unless my Sister should have and live lawfully begotten of her body but if she has such son I give the Legacy last to him and his heirs forever Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my Brother Matthew Harris as my whole and sole Executor to this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 25th day of April 1832.

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 11th day of March 1832. This last Will and Testament of Henry Harris deceased proved by the Oaths of Benjamin Griffin and Jas. Howell two of the Witnesses thereto and sworn to be according to the nature of Matthew Harris the Executor therein named who made oath and together with John Harris and William Harris his Sureties sworn to and acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs. Anticipate & granted himself obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form.

In the Name of God Amen I Polly Glover of Southampton County and State of Virginia being of Sound mind and perfect memory do make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows.

Item 1st I Commit my Soul into the hands of Almighty God and my body I give and bequeath in a decent Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executor hereinafter named.

Item 2nd After my death I desire that all my just debts be paid in or as to do so but if there be not cash in hand sufficient I desire that my Executor may sell so much of my Estate my request accepted as may be sufficient to discharge all my just debts.

Item 3rd I give and bequeath unto my beloved Sister Polly Daugherty all my Estate of every kind whatsoever of at my death both real and personal to her and to her heirs and assigns forever to dispose of at her death as she may think proper Item 4th I nominate and appoint my beloved Sister Polly Daugherty to be my lawful Executor. Signed sealed acknowledged and delivered by my last Will hereby revoking all others which have been heretofore made.
