In the name of God Amen I Henry Harris of the County of Southampton being of sound mind and memory do hereby declare that I have made this paper writing as and for my last Will and Testament in manner and form following Viz.

Item 1<sup>st</sup> My Will and desire is that my Executors hereinafter named do sell all my Estate of every kind whatsoever both real and personal and divide the proceeds thereof after paying my just debts to the following persons and in the following manner I give and bequeath to my Sister Polly Harris the Sum of fifty dollars to her and her heirs forever I give and bequeath to my Sister Sarah Harris One month part of the Remainder of my Estate to her and her heirs forever I give and bequeath to my Sister Samuel Harris one month part as above to him and his heirs forever I also give and bequeath to each of the following persons namely Henry Turner the wife of Jacobus Turner, Matthew Harris William Harris John Harris Polly Harris and Zachariah Royal one month part of my Estate after the payment of fifty dollars as above to them and their heirs forever I send the use of One month part of my Estate (after the legacy as above) to my Sister Rebecca Johnson the wife of Malcom Johnson for and during her natural life and at her death to return to my Executors to be equally divided between them unless my Sister should have and have lawfully begetten of her body but if she has such issue I give the Legacy first to her and her heirs forever Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my brother Matthew Harris as my whole and sole Executor to this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 25<sup>th</sup> day of April 1832

John Hornell 1832. This last Will and Testament of Henry Harris did read  
William Griffin proved by the Oaths of Benjamin Griffin and John Hornell two of  
the Witnesses thereto and sworn to be according and in the nature of Matthew Harris  
the Executor therein named who made oath and together with John Harris and  
William Harris his Executors witnesses with and acknowledged a Oath in the penalty of  
One thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs. Certificate is granted herefor obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form

Item 2<sup>nd</sup> After my death I desire that all my just debts be paid or as to do as best as there be not cash on hand sufficient I desire that my Executors may settle do much of my Estate my debts (excepted) as may be sufficient to discharge all my just debts.

Item 3<sup>rd</sup> I give and bequeath unto my beloved Sister Polly Daughterly all my estate of what kind soever of at my death both real and personal to her and to her heirs and assigns forever to the use of at her death, as she may think proper Item 4<sup>th</sup> I nominate and appoint my beloved Sister Polly Daughterly to be my lawful Executor I give sealed acknowledged and delivered to my last Will and Testament reciting all things which have been herebefore made.
