The Commissioner is directed by the Adm to make a statement of the demand which the children of the intestate claim under the will of their Grand father Absalom Williamson to wit. The intestate intermarried with Maria Ann the daughter of the said Absalom to whom the said Absalom bequeathed during her life and at her death them to be equally divided among her children, there was also a Legacy of \$25.00 given to her in the same manner, and to be divided in the same way. The said Maria Ann departed this life on the 13th day of May 1828. I am directed to state that previous to her death the intestate sold the following negroes Sabry a girl for \$260. and Tony Scham for \$375. which is proved by Sales Summors see his aff. dea et heretofore filed. The Adm also states that the intestate also sold another girl named Judy for \$250. which he will be able to prove if it should be desired. The said children now claim the amount Sales of these negroes from the death of their mother with interest. They also claim the heirs of the negroes, not sold, up to the death of the intestate, with the amount is stated in the following manner.
