Item In case my wife Emeline should have a lawful issue of my body it is my
will and desire that it should be raised and educated out of my estate.

Item In case my wife Emeline should marry and my child should live it is
my will and desire that my wife should have one third part of my estate as a dowry
and the other two thirds to my child for the benefit of raising and educating the said

Item It is my will and desire in case my child should die under age and without issue
I give to John S. Baker my gun to him and his heirs forever. And as to the debts of
my wife Emeline, I give all my estate to John Biddle and Mary Biddle both real and
personal to them and their heirs forever.

Lastly, I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my friend William B. B. B.
