 in manner and form following Viz.

 Secondly I give to my Son Abraham L Garder my negro boy Dierly and his heirs forever.
 Thirdly I give to Esau Garder one bed and furniture to him and his heirs forever.
 Fourthly I leave all the balance of my estate to be sold by my executor and the proceeds to
 be equally divided in two parts and I give one six part to James Garder and his heirs
 forever I give one six part to Abraham Garder and his heirs forever. I give one six
 part to my grand children Polly Beeman Elizabeth Beeman and Mary Beeman to
 them and their heirs forever. I give one six part to my grand children Emphemy Bux-
 ton and Mildred Buxton to them and their heirs forever. I give one six part to my
 grand children Ann Eliza Booth, Arthur Booth, ^{the grand Virginia Booth which is George W. Booth} James Emerson Booth, and Henry
 Bannion Booth to them and their heirs forever. I give one six part to my grand son
 Emphemy Garder to him and his heirs forever. Lastly I do hereby appoint
 my beloved Son Abraham L Garder my executor to this my last Will and Testament
 his annulling all other wills or wills heretofore made by me and declare this to be
 my last Will and testament. At Witness whereof I have set my hand and
 affixed my Seal this 5th day of July in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hun-
 dred and Twenty One.

 to him and his heirs forever.
- 3rd I constitute and appoint my friend Nathan Suter my whole and sole executor
 to this my last Will and Testament hereby, nullifying all other wills by me heretofore
