 thousand dollars Conditional as the Court directs, Certificate is granted him for obtaining a
 probat of the said Will in due form.

In the name of God Amen I William Ferguson of Southampton County and State of Vir-
 ginia being weak in body but of sound mind and memory do make this my last Will
 and Testament in the following manner to wit: first its my wish that my Executor here-
 after named, shall pay all my Just debts by selling such property as he may think will
 be most expedient; after which I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Mary Ferguson
 the Plantation whereon I now live with the property remaining after my sale; during
 her widowhood that she may take care of my Children; but should she marry then its
 my wish for her to take one third of my estate, and the balance to be taken possession of
 by my executor for the benefit of my Children is to be equally divided. I nominate my
 friend Alfred Story Executor of this my last Will, and requests him to sell a small
 tract of land say three or four Acres adjoining the lands of Richard Jordan & Geo.
Burgan and the money to be equally divided between my Children then living.
 In Witness whereof I have set my hand & seal this 16th day of Aug^r 1834.
