 purpose to the age of twenty one years my Will is that the said Catharine Barnes Legacy should go to the
 above named James Barnes son of James Barnes dec^d and if the said James Barnes should die before
 arrive to the age of twenty one years My Will is that the said Catharine Barnes should have the Legacy
 of the said James Barnes, and in case both of the above named James Barnes and Catharine should die with-
 out an heir lawfully begotten of their before they arrive to the age of twenty one years My Will
 is that both of the above named Legacies should go to my wife Martha Barnes to have and her
 heirs forever.
