

Peter Russell In the name of God Amen I Peter Russell of Southhampton County being of sound mind and perfect memory do make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament in manner & form following to wit:
 1st I Give to my daughter Elizabeth Russell a tract of land the line beginning at a Mill race at Bangs Crumpler line thence as straight line west course to a old well at Turners place from there a stone line north course to the road, all my land south and west of this said line taken by purchase for ever.
 I also give her one feather Bed.
 2nd I Give to my daughter Polly Russell my plantation at this I have given to her and her heirs forever I also give her one feather Bed.
 3rd I Give all the remaining part of my estate both real and personal to be sold and all my just debts paid, the balance to be equally divided between my two daughters Elizabeth & Polly Russell, and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my friend Benjamin Crumpler my sole executor to this my last Will and Testament Given under my hand and seal this 21st day of January 1835

Mahlon C. Notsworthy, and *Corn L. Crumpler* the Witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded
 And on the motion of Benjamin Crumpler the Executor therein named was made oath and
 together with James Rowe and James S Jones his sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond
 in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs. Certificate is granted
 him for obtaining a precept of said Will in due form.
