Will

I, James M. Williams of Southampton County do make my last Will and Testament as the manner and form following to wit: I give to my grand daughter Susanina Becken, who is the daughter of Susanina Woodwards, the whole of my property of all kinds, consisting of cattle, hives, and household furniture, kitchen utensils, and my wearing apparel: if at my death there should be any property left other than the kinds mentioned, or there should be an increase of what is named, I give the whole to my grand daughter; but if my said grand daughter should be dead at the time of my death, I then give it to my daughter Susanina Woodwards and if she should be both dead at the time of my death I then give my whole property to my brother Charles M. Williams or to his heirs if he should be dead. In Witness of the above I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this eighteenth day of August in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighteen.
