my just debts, all the property both real and personal that I am possessed
with at my death to him and his heirs forever
I do hereby utterly disannul and revoke every other Will or Wills heretofore

day of August 1835. The last Will and Testament of
William D Pope. Rebecca Wright dec^d was proved by the oath of William
Nicholson and William D Pope Two of the Justices of the Peace and Oaths were
recorded. And on the motion of Thomas D Wright who made oath and signed
with William A Nicholson & William D Pope his securities entered into and acknowledged
a bond in the penalty of Five hundred dollars conditioned as the law in that behalf
directs is granted him for full and complete satisfaction on the estate of the said
Rebecca Wright and with her Will annexed in due form.
