Pursuant to an Order of the County Court of Southampton dated January Court 1832 the undersigned have examined stated and settled Thos B Woods & Edmund Phelps Executors of the Estate of Edwin Wood deceased according to the schedule laid before us and found a balance due the estate of Ten thousand eight hundred and seventy eight dollars seventy eight cents including three hundred and fifty one dollars ninety five cents interest to December 24th 1834 as above stated; from which sum we have deducted thirty five dollars and six cents (by consent of the Legation) leaving two thousand eight hundred and forty three dollars seventy two cents which sum divided into three equal parts makes nine hundred and forty seven dollars ninety one cents to each Legation for which the said Executors have the following receipts.
