The sum of Twenty three dollars 07 1/2 cents to Elizabeth Bailey, the same sum as above to Antine Bailey, the same sum to Nancy Bailey, the same sum, to Mary Bailey the same sum - Bailey & - Bailey of the half blood one full share making the sum of Eleven dollars 50 1/2 cents to each one of them making one full share. All which is respectfully submitted to the Court.
