knowing that it is expedient for all men now to live, to make constitutions and ordain this
my last Will and Testament in manner and form as followeth (to wit)

Imprimis. First I give and bequeath to my dear wife Mary Statler, Junr \$100, One
hundred and fifty dollars, to her and her heirs forever,

Secondly. I give unto my beloved Brother William R. Crocker, either Richard and myself
Crocker and my niece Bonilla Thompson, my Nephew William R. Cobb and his Sister Mary Ann
Cobb both together to have one share of my Estate, equally to be divided between all above men
tions except my niece Statler Junr \$100 and the shares of the said Bonilla Thompson, William
R. Cobb and his Sister Mary Ann Cobb to remain in the hands of William R. Crocker to be
paid to them as he may think proper.

Lastly. I appoint my beloved Brother William R. Crocker Executor of this my last will
and testament, hereby revoking all other former Wills made by me. In witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this fourth day of January in the year of
our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty six.
