I Richard Crocker of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia being sick and weak in body but of a sound and disposing memory and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make constitute and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form as followeth (to wit)

Imprimus. First I give and bequeath to my dear beloved Niece Statira, Jane Pope, one hundred and fifty dollars, to her and her heirs forever.

Secondly. I give unto my beloved Brother, William M. Crocker, Nathan J. Crocker and Joseph Crocker and my niece Annelle Thompson, my Nephew, William A. Kott and his sister Mary Ann Kott both both together to have one share of my Estate, equally to be divided between all above mentioned except my niece Statira Jane Pope and the shares of the said Annelle Thompson, William A. Kott and his sister Mary Ann Kott to remain in the hands of William M. Crocker to be paid to them as he may think proper.

Lastly. I appoint my beloved Brother William M. Crocker Executor of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all other former Wills made by me. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this fourth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty six.
