Being blessed by almighty God with a sound mind and supping memory I do hereby make, ex-
 Jacob Mordant's estate, and affirm this my last will and testament in manner and form following. That is to say,
 I give and devise to my daughter Elizabeth Gilt, for and during her life, and for the purposes
 hereinafter expressed, that part of my lands lying and situated within the following boundaries. Begin-
 ning at the corner near Lewis (Tregent's) gate, thence across the various courses of said Tregent's
 lane to an old sown and to the center of the swamp which is a boundary for James Scott
 and myself, thence up said swamp or branch to a line of marked trees, and thence along Scott's
 lane to where it comes on the parcel of land purchased by me of Thomas (Jones), thence by a
 new line to be drawn parallel with the lane leading up to my house and continuing across
 to the long lane to J. D. Maffonburg's lane, thence along Maffonburg's and Tregent's lane to the
 beginning. I have and to hold the same during her life, for the support of herself and raising and
 educating her two sons Joseph and James Gilt, and after her death I give and devise the said
 tract or parcel of land to the said Joseph and James Gilt, and their heirs forever, subject to
 such condition with regard to part as may be hereafter expressed both as regards the life
 estate and the fee simple interest. I also give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Gilt
 all my negro man Willis for the same period, and for the same purposes, that I give
