

last, to him and his heirs forever. I also give him the said John C. Beal and one large Iron Little one grain stone, one adze, one apple mill and all my iron tools to him and his heirs forever.

2^d I give to my Daughter Polly Musser's children the other half of my legacy from the Estate of said Edward Beal decd. and interest thereon from the 20th day of Decem. be last, to be equally divided between them, to them and their heirs forever. I desire that Mr. Peter Edwards should receive the legacy hereby bequeathed to my said daughter Polly Musser's children for their benefit, and pay it to them as they arrive at lawful age.

3^d I give to my daughter Lydia Musser one dollar to her and her heirs forever.

4th After the payment of the above legacy and my just debts and funeral expenses by my Executors herein after named, I give one fourth part of the remainder of my estate to my daughter Polly Musser, to her and her heirs forever. I also give to my daughter Lydia Musser's children one fourth part of the remainder of my Estate to be equally divided between them, to them and their heirs forever. I leave one fourth part of the remainder of my estate to my daughter Lucy Ferguson and her daughter Lydia Ferguson, and if either should die, I leave the said fourth part of the remainder of my estate to the survivor during her natural life, and give the same to their lawful begotten heirs. I desire that Capt. James Barnes of Northam County N.C. should receive the legacy hereby bequeathed to my daughter Lucy Ferguson and her daughter Lydia Ferguson, and pay it to them as they may need it, and if both the said Lucy Ferguson and Lydia Ferguson should die without a lawful begotten heir, then I give the said legacy or so much thereof as remains, to my daughter Polly Musser's children, to them and their heirs forever, and I also give the other fourth of the remainder of my estate to my daughter Rebecca Beal to her and her heirs forever.

And lastly, I do hereby nominate and appoint my friends Peter Edwards and Thos. B. Morrell, executors of this my last Will and testament, hereby revoking all other or former Wills or testaments by me heretofore made.
