In the name of God Amen, I James Harris of Southampton County of State of
Virginia being in sound mind & memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testa-
ment. I give unto my daughter Sophia Simmons wife of Donald Simmons two dol-
lars to her and her heirs forever.

2nd. I give unto my grand daughter Charlotte Ann Harris fifty dollars. provided she
arrives to the age of eighteen years. if she should die under that age my will and desire
is that the fifty dollars should go to my son Anthony Harris to him and his heirs forever.

3rd. My will and desire is that my wife Nancy Harris should live on my plan-
tation as long as she lives and be supported by my son Anthony Harris.

4th. I give unto my son Anthony Harris my land wherein I now live, contain-
ing one hundred and nearly five acres, to the same more or less. to him and his heirs
forever, also all my stock. Horses. cattle. sheep &c and all my plantation slave-
s, household, bed, kitchen furniture also my tools all my money and books to him and
his heirs forever.

5th and lastly. I nominate and appoint my friend Willis Turner and my son An-
THONY Harris my executors to this my last Will and Testament, revoking all others here-
fore made, as witness my hand and seal this 26th day of December one thousand
eight hundred and twenty-nine.
