I Elias Love of the County of Southampton do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following witnesseth

1st It is my Will and desire that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid.

2nd I give and bequeath to my son Benjamin Love twenty dollars, which is to be given him at the death of Deborah Baisden to him and his heirs forever.

3rd I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Eakum one feather bed and furniture to her and her heirs forever.

4th I like to Deborah Baisden the use of all my lands during her natural life - also I lend her all my personal Estate of what nature and kind soever, and at her death it is my Will and desire that my land or the one hundred acres that I now live on and purchased of Allen and Thomas Dilbeck should be equally divided between my two sons that I have had known of Deborah Baisden by the names of Nathan Baisden and Thomas Baisden provided that they let all my daughters that I have had known of Deborah Baisden by the names of Dasha, Juley, Martha, Esther, Anna & Peggy live on the plantation during their single life to them my two sons and their heirs forever.

5th I give and bequeath by my son Elijah Baisden the lands that I purchased of Henry Love containing by estimation thirty five acres to him and his heirs forever.

6th I constitute and appoint my friend Peter Booth my sole Executor to this my last will and Testament as aforesaid and revoking all the Will before made by me. And it is also my desire that my Executor should make no public sale of my house of any part of my property but should there not be money enough on the house at my death, that he should consult Deborah Baisden of what property she would best spare and that he make private sale of the same. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 14th day of July 1824.
