In the name of God Amen! I Elizabeth Stanton of the State of Virginia County of Loudon do
 Elizabeth Stanton make & ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following:
 Item As I have heretofore given to my daughter Mary C. Foster, formerly Stanton, two negroes
 the legacy intended for her (to wit, Abraham & Mary.) I now propose to dispose of the balance of my
 estate as follows.

Item I give to my son-in-law Kinchen Felks & his Wife Nancy Felks, the following Negroes.
 To wit, one negro boy named Ezekiel, one woman, Martha & her child with all their increase,
 to them and their heirs forever.

Item I leave to the said Kinchen & Nancy Felks, all my other negroes, together with all estate
 of whatsoever kind, during their natural lives, after their death my will & assets is that all the
 Estate with its increase shall be equally divided between all the heirs of the said Nancy Felks,
 before named to them & their heirs forever. — The names of the negroes above named are Frank,
 Moses, Jack, Phillis, Manassah & Lucretia.

Lastly, I leave & appoint my son-in-law, Kinchen Felks, the sole Executor to this my last
 Will & Testament.
