 perfect memory, do make and declare this my last will and Testament - in manner and form following,
 to wit:

- Item 2nd. I give and bequeath to my daughter Sally Briggans one fourth his and furniture to her and
 her heirs forever.
- Item 3rd. I give and bequeath unto my son James Harris the residue of my estate both real and
 personal, to him and his heirs forever.

Lastly, I constitute and appoint my son James Harris Executor to this my last Will and Testament.
