1st I give to my friends and relations Mills Pope all of my land lying in the County of Southampton to him and his heirs forever.

2ndly I give to my niece Mary Elizabeth Whitlow daughter of Richard Whitlow one hundred dollars to be applied to her education.

3rdly I give to Virginia A.D. and Frances Rebecca Pope daughters of Spotsly Pope decd. one hundred dollars each of them and their heirs forever.

4thly After paying all of my just debts I give the whole of the balance of my estate to Mills Pope to him and his heirs forever. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 16th day of May A.D.
