

work, and as the receipts were small, the bonds have allowed him. The admr also directed the Court to state, that the reason why this settlement has been procrastinated, was, that there was doubt as to the distribution of the balance due the estate, and because he was consulted by different officers given for a considerable time, and that in addition to this he states that he has made considerable advancements to most of the debtors and that every little is due to many of them, and if this fact should be made appear, as he considers it can, he considers that he should be allowed the bonds on the sales of the Lands and Estates, which the Comr has not allowed in this settlement. If the Court should however allow the same, these Commissions which would amount to £172 2s the balances of principal there due the estate would be £357 3s with the same amount of Interest as above stated. bonds fee £7 5s charged to the admr.
