I Henry Senne of the County of Southhampton and State of Virginia, do hereby make my last Will and Testament in manner and form following, That is to say,
 Item: I bequeath to my Wife Frances Senne, my plantation wherein I now reside during her natural life.
 Item: I do leave her a negro man Jerry & his wife Hannah also during her natural life with their two children.
 Item: I also leave her my Carriage with two Coach Horses only during her natural life.
 Item: I give and bequeath also to her fifty barrels of Corn and two Hundred and pound flax and five hundred pounds of Bacon.
 Item: I leave to her her share of her own Choice for the Corns and Fats and all my empty barrels.
 Item: I give and bequeath to her One Hundred dollars to her and her heirs forever.
 Item: I give and bequeath to my son James Senne, my plantation known by the name of the new plantation to him and his heirs forever.
 Item: I give and bequeath to him two hundred dollars to him and his heirs.
 Item: I give and bequeath to my son Joseph Senne my plantation named Berlin formerly Cleaves place with all the adjoining lands, included in that title to him and his heirs.
 Item: I give and bequeath to him the sum of One Hundred dollars to him and his heirs.
 Item: I give and bequeath to him also two Sides of Choice with Corns and appurtenances.
 Item: I give and bequeath to my son Jacob Senne the sold of my Notes tract of Land with all the Land adjoining the same to him and his heirs.
 Item: I also give and bequeath to my son Jacob Senne the sum of three hundred dollars to him & his heirs.
 Item: I also give him the tract of Land which I purchased of the heirs of John Peters also two tracts or parcels of Land which I purchased of Samuel Swans to him and his heirs.
 Item: I give and bequeath to him One Side of Choice and Choice.
 Item: I give and bequeath to my daughter Anne Ma Senne all my lands lying in Transylvania & Co. to her and her heirs.
 Item: I also give to her five hundred dollars to her and her heirs.
 Item: I give and bequeath to my daughter Louisa Senne after the death of my Wife the plantation wherein I now reside with all the lands in that title.
 Item: I give and bequeath to her the sum of five hundred dollars to her and her heirs.
 Item: I give and bequeath to her my last Clock which is now in my house to her & her heirs.
 Item: I give and bequeath to my niece Martha Wellman my plantation which I bought of a Mrs. Drury to her and her heirs.
 Item: I give and bequeath to her ~~one~~ hundred dollars to her and her heirs forever.
 Item: I desire after the deaths of my Wife Frances Senne wish that all the property I did leave to her to be equally divided between my Children Joseph Senne, Jacob Senne, Henry the Senne and Louisa Senne.
 Item: I give the Land which I purchased of the heirs of John Senne and my daughter Louisa Senne.
 Item: I give and bequeath to my son Jacob Senne, provided he pays to Hannah the Senne and Louisa Senne One hundred dollars each the plantation named Runna Hill near the fork of the Roads, with all the Land adjoining that tract to him and his heirs.
 Item: I leave after my decease all the rest of my whole both real and personal of what nature or kind soever it may not be in my particular capacity of to be sold to the highest bidder and after paying all my Just debts the balance to be equally divided between my Children Joseph Senne, Jacob Senne, Martha the Senne and Louisa Senne. And Lastly I do hereby last, will and appoint my Wife Frances Senne my executrix of this my last Will and Testament. In Witnes whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 15th day of January A.D. 1733.
