County Court of Southampton made on the 19th day of March 1833
to admit to record a certain Writing bearing date the 16th day of January 1833
as the true last Will and Testament of Henry Lenoir deceased.

This day came the parties by their Attorneys and were sworn and examined and sundry papers and the proceedings of the County Court of Southampton respecting a Writing bearing date the 16th day of January 1833 offered for proof in this said County Court as the Will and Testament of Henry Lenoir deceased, read and the parties appeared by their Counsel fully heard. It was to the Court here that the said Henry Lenoir deceased at the time of executing the Writing aforesaid dated the 16th day of January 1833 was of sound and disposing mind and memory and that he was under no undue influence and that the same was duly executed and a Justice according to Law, and that the Order of the said County Court is erroneous. Therefore it is awarded by this Court that the same be reversed and annulled and that the said Writing of the 16th day of January 1833 be removed from the last Will and Testament of the said Henry Lenoir dec^d and that the Appellant recover against the Appellee his Cost by him incurred in said Court as aforesaid.
