Testament in manner and form following Viz
1st I give to my son Hawkins Pines all my lands I possess and one negro woman
by the name of old Ester, an another woman by the name of Martha, lands, and
some negro slaves to him and his heirs forever -
2nd I give to my daughter Melana Pines the following negro slaves to wit, a negro
man by the name of Isaac, and another one by the name of Sam, an other one by the name
of Robt, a young negro girl by the name of young Ester, an other negro woman by the name
of Abby and her three children by the name of Miles, Adam, and Adele to her and
her heirs forever -
3rd I give to my grand son William L Pines my parcel of land called and known
to him and his heirs forever -
4th I give to my grand daughter Abby Ann Clark one further lot and pasture to her and
her heirs forever -
5th My Will and desire is that all my just debts be paid and the residue of all my prop-
erty to be sold, and the money arising from said sales to be equally divided between my son
Hawkins Pines and my daughter Melana Pines to them and their heirs forever -
6th And lastly I do hereby appoint my son Hawkins Pines and John Pines executors of
my said Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand &
affixed my seal this 28th day of July 1832.
