At a Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery held for the County of Southampton, on the 3^d day of May 1848. And at a like Court held on the 4th day of May 1849, the said account having lain over one term and there being no exceptions thereto, was confirmed and ordered to be recorded.

Will.

In the name of God, Amen: I, Thomas Newson of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, do hereby make and publish this my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following that is to say.

1st. After my decease, I desire all my just debts and funeral expenses, be paid by my Executors hereinafter named.

2^d. On condition that William Spury shall not claim any pay from my Estate for his services rendered for me during my life time, I give and bequeath to him and his heirs forever my Dick plantation adjoining the lands of William Barnes dec^d and others, also my negro man Dick (at Poplar field plantation) one feather bed and furniture, one horse of average value, three hundred pounds of Pork, three barrels corn, one cow and Pigs and all the claims I hold against him, but in case he shall claim payment for his said services, then all the above gift or legacy hereby bequeathed to him and his heirs shall be null and void, and I give and bequeath the same to John D. Myrick and his heirs forever.

3^d. On condition that Eliza Darby shall not claim any pay from my Estate for her services rendered for me during my life time, I give and bequeath to her and her heirs forever my Negro girl Vick and her child, and her future increase, if any, also one feather bed and furniture (up stairs over the dining room), but in case she should claim payment for her said services, then all the gift or legacy hereby bequeathed to her and her heirs, shall be null and void, and I give and bequeath the same to John D. Myrick and his heirs forever.

4th. I give and bequeath to George H. Fogg and his heirs forever my Negro girl Henrietta and her future increase, if any.

5th. I give and bequeath to Ridley Drake and his heirs forever my Negro woman Malinda and her future increase if any, also the sum of One hundred dollars.

6th. I give and bequeath to Elisabeth Waponding and her heirs the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars, to be paid by
