

At a Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery, held for the County of Southampton, on the 7th day of November 1879. And on the motion of John D. Myrick, One of the Executors therein named, who made oath and together with Ben C. Pope, H. P. Pope James Maget, Walter Myrick, Thomas N. Myrick, Alexander Myrick, Wm: A. Mapenbush and John M. Neale, his securities, who justified as to their sufficiency, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One hundred thousand dollars, conditioned as the Law directs; Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of said will in due form: Liberator is reserved for the other Executor to join in the said probate when he thinks fit.
