To the Circuit Court of Southampton County

Your Commissioner reports to the Court, that on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of July 1857 Wm M Jones and Iesr Parker Jr Execrators of Iesr Parker Senior deceased laid before your Commissioner a Statement of all the money which they the said Wm M Jones and Iesr Parker Jr had received or become chargeable with, or had disbursed within the time unbroken from their qualifications and that time, together with the vouchers for such disbursements. That the Commissioner embraced the said Execrators in the list of fiduciaries whose accounts were laid before him for Settlement, which was posted at the front door of the Courthouse of Said County on the first day of August Term of Said Court, and on the date of this report (ten days having elapsed since the said account was mentioned in the said list) made up and completed the foregoing account of said Execrators transactions on the estate of the said Iesr Parker dec'd and on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of November 1857 finds a balance of \$3886.84 due from the Execrators to the said Estate. All principal. The account is supported by satisfactory vouchers, and is herewith returned.

Your Commissioner further reports to the Court, that he has examined whether the said Execrators have given such bond as the law requires, and whether it is in a proper and with securities sufficient and finds the same to be unobjectionable and fully sufficient.

Your Commissioner further reports that at the request of the Execrators he has divided the balance in their hands on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of November 1857 amongst the several legatees, the children of the said Iesr Parker Senior in accordance with the provisions of his last Will and Testament, and made up and respectfully reports the foregoing accounts with the said legatees.

Your Commissioner further reports that the Execrators have fully settled up the estate with the exception of one or two debts due the estate which are incident at this time, but should they be hereafter collected they will account for them.
