To the Circuit Court of Southampton County.

Your Commissioner reports to the Court on the 11th day of October last James W. Murfie Executor of Simon Murfie deceased before your Commissioner a Statement of all money which he the said James W. Murfie had received or became chargeable with or had disbursed. That the Commissioner examined the said Executor in the list of Fiduciaries whose accounts were before him for Settlement which was posted at the front door of the Courthouse of said County on the first day of October Term last of the County Court of said County, and on the date of this report (Four days having elapsed since the said account was mentioned in the said list) made up and completed the foregoing account of the said James W. Murfie's Executive Proceedings on the estate of the said Simon Murfie deceased and on the 19th day of October 1857, finds a balance of \$219.77 due from the Executor to the said Estate, of which sum \$12.92 is interest. The account is supported by satisfactory vouchers and is herewith returned.

Your Commissioner further reports to the Court that he has examined whether the said Executor has given such bond as the law requires, and whether it is in openably and with securities sufficient and finds the same to be unsatisfactory and fully sufficient.
