To the Circuit Court of Southampton County.

Your Commissioner reports to Court that James E. Brighton the late administrator of Elizabeth Little's Estate has exhibited before him a statement of all money received by the said administrator or with which he had become chargeable or had disbursed, during the period embraced in the foregoing account together with the vouchers in support of the disbursements. That he finds a balance of Fourteen hundred and thirty three dollars and sixty eight cents to be due by the said Administrator to the said Estate on the 31st day of December 1857, with interest thereon from that day. That the said account is supported by satisfactory vouchers, and that the said James E. Brighton has given such bond as the law requires, the penalty whereof and the securities thereto are sufficient in the opinion of the Commissioner.
