To the Circuit Court of Southampton County.

Your Commissioner reports to the Court that on the 27th day of August 1857, Anselm B. Verguhart administrator of John Verguhart dec^d exhibited before your Commissioner a Statement of all the moneys which he the said Anselm B. Verguhart had received or become chargeable with or had disbursed up to the 1st day of August 1858 together with the vouchers for such disbursements. That the said Commissioner embraced the said administrator in the list of Fiduciaries whose accounts were before him for settlement which was posted up at the front door of the Courthouse of said County on the first day of September Term 1857. and on the date of this report (ten days having elapsed since the said account was mentioned in the said list) made up and completed the foregoing account of the said Anselm B. Verguharts administration of the estate of the said John Verguhart dec^d and on the 1st day of August 1858 finds a balance of \$4897.25 + due from the administrator to the said estate, of which sum \$857.29 + is interest. The account is supported by satisfactory vouchers and is herewith returned. Your Commissioner further reports to the Court that he has examined whether the said administrator has given such bond as the law requires and whether it is in a formally and with sureties sufficient, and finds the same to be unquestionable and fully sufficient.
