To the Circuit Court of Southampton County.

Your Commissioner reports to Court that James W. Murfee the Executor of Simon Murfee has exhibited before him a statement of all moneys received by the said Executor or with which he had become chargeable or had disbursed during the periods embraced in the foregoing account together with the vouchers in support of the disbursements. That he finds a balance of \$191.02 to be due by the said Executor to the said Estate on the 19th day of January 1859 with interest on \$162.90 from that day. That the said account is supported by satisfactory vouchers, and that the said Executor has given such bond as the law requires, the penalty whereof and the securities thereto are sufficient in the opinion of the Commissioner.
