1. In the Name of God Amen. I Caroline M. Boykin of the County of Southampton State of Virginia, being of Sound Mind, do hereby make and declare this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form following to wit:

Item 1<sup>st</sup>. I give to my Son Richard S. Boykin a tract of Land, Called the Taylor's Tract, lying in the above named County and bounded by the Lands of John Boykin deceased and others, also a negro woman Amanda, her two Children, and her future increase.

2<sup>d</sup>. I desire that all of my other property of whatsoever kind, Money, or its representative, household furniture &c also any property of any kind that I may be in possession of in the State of Georgia to be equally divided between my two Children Mary Virginia Boykin and Richard S. Boykin.

3<sup>rd</sup>. If Richard S. Boykin who is now a minor, should die before he reaches the age of twenty one, then and in that event I desire that his portion should go to his Sister Mary V. Boykin and if the said Mary V. Boykin should die without a Child or Children then and in that event her portion to revert to her brother, the said Richard S. Boykin.

4<sup>th</sup>. I give to Miss. Wilmette Jones one bed and furniture.
