I, Walter B. Holland, of the Town of Franklin, in the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, do by this Writing make my last will and Testament. In the first place I leave One third of my Estate, real, personal & choses, and where-ever the same may be, unto my beloved wife Mary C. for and during her Natural life, and at her death I give, bequeath, and devise the same to my two Daughters and my Children, Bertie and Henrietta. Secondly, The other two thirds of my Estate, of every sort and description, I give, bequeath and devise unto my said Daughters, Bertie and Henrietta and in the event of the death of One of them under living One year of age, and without issue, then the whole of the two thirds is to go to the surviving Child, and in case of the death of both of them under living One year of age, and without issue, I leave to my beloved wife Mary C. during her Natural life, One half of the said two thirds of my Estate, the remainder of the two thirds of my Estate to go to my nearest living relatives, and in case of the death of my beloved wife Mary C. I devise, bequeath and give the whole two thirds of the Estate hereinbefore mentioned to my nearest living relatives to be equally divided among them. Lastly, I appoint Frank Holland of the Town of Franklin, Va. Guardian for my two Children Bertie and Henrietta, and the said Frank Holland and Cecil C. Vaughan, Administrators of my Estate. In Witness Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and
