

Thirdly: after the death of my said wife, or at the time of her marriage, if she should marry again, I give and devise all my said real Estate, in fee simple, to Dr William W. Murray, now living at Suffolk, Va. and to his heirs and assigns forever.

Fourthly: I hereby revoke all Wills and Codicils hitherto at any time made by me.
In Witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and seal this tenth day of February in the year of our Lord, one thousand Eight hundred and Eighty seven.
