

all my Negroes &c. all kinds of property, whatsoever that I may be in possession of at my death, after my just debts are paid, but in case my beloved wife marry again or die I leave to my son George W. Pledger the use of my Negroes Nancy & Elizabeth & during of his natural life & after his decease it is my will & desire that the above named Negroes shall be equally divided between all my sons George W. Pledger boy children to them and their heirs forever.

Item 3rd. I leave to my daughter Sally Gumb if in case she should be left without any home or piece of Land from the road along the ditch up the mountain in during of her natural life or widowhood.

Item 4th. I leave the use of all my lands and plantations to my son George W. Pledger after my wife deceased in during of his natural life & after his death it is my wish and desire that my Lands be equally divided between Melk. his Pledger & Kitchen Pledger my grandsons to them & their heirs forever.

Item 5th. It is my will and desire that Sally, Matilda & Charity Pledger my two Grand Daughters shall have my negroes girls named Mammy and of either of them are without lawful heirs the surviving one have the sole right of goes to them and their heirs forever.

Item 6. I give my Daughter Sally Gumb one dollar to her and to her heirs forever.

Item 7th. I give my son John Pledger one hundred and fifty dollars to him and his heirs forever.

Item 8. I give unto my son Silas Pledger one hundred fifty dollars to him and his heirs forever.

Item 9. I give unto my grandson William Lee fifty dollars to him and his heirs forever.

Item. I give unto my girl unto my grandson Silas Lee fifty dollars to him and his heirs forever.

Item. I give unto my grand daughter Lucy Pledger fifty dollars to her and her heirs forever.

Item. It is my will and desire that my Stock of Horses, cattle and hogs those horses kitchen furniture be sold after my wife decease to pay of these legacies above given.

Item. I do nominate & appoint my friend Hinchen Powell my whole & sole executor to this my last will & testament disannulling all other wills heretofore made by me in this place whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of May in the year of 1836

An authenticated copy of the last Will & Testament of John Pledger deceased was returned and ordered to be recorded. Williams, his Sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs certificated is granted him for obtaining a probate of said Will in due form.
