And on the motion of M'Henry M'Henry, one of the executors named in this said Will, she made oath and together with Benjamin T. Smith, Beant J. Briffon and Elias S. M'Henry his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Fifteen thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, Certificate is granted him for obtaining a grant of the said will in due form. Liberty is reserved the other executors named in this said Will to join in the probate and administration.

In the name of God Amen. I John (Bt being) in perfect soundness of mind and memory, but somewhat being it is affirmed John tells me for all now to die. I do make & ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows, viz.

First I give and bequeath to my beloved wife, Jane Cobb, during her natural life one half of my estate both real and personal and at her death I give it to be equally divided between my children if any living, if none living, I give it to be equally divided between Edward Edwards son of James H. Edwards decd. and Martha Ann Cobb daughter of M'Henry decd. if they are living, if not to my lawful heirs to them and their heirs forever.

Secondly I give and bequeath the other half of my estate to be equally divided between my children if any, if none I give it to my beloved wife during her life, and at her death I give it to be distributed in the same manner and to the same persons I have given the other half.

Thirdly I testify I request my friends Simon Moser to execute this my last Will and Testament and to be guardian of my children if any, and do declare this to be my last will and Testament whereunto I have set my hand and fixed my seal the 16th day of February 1807.
